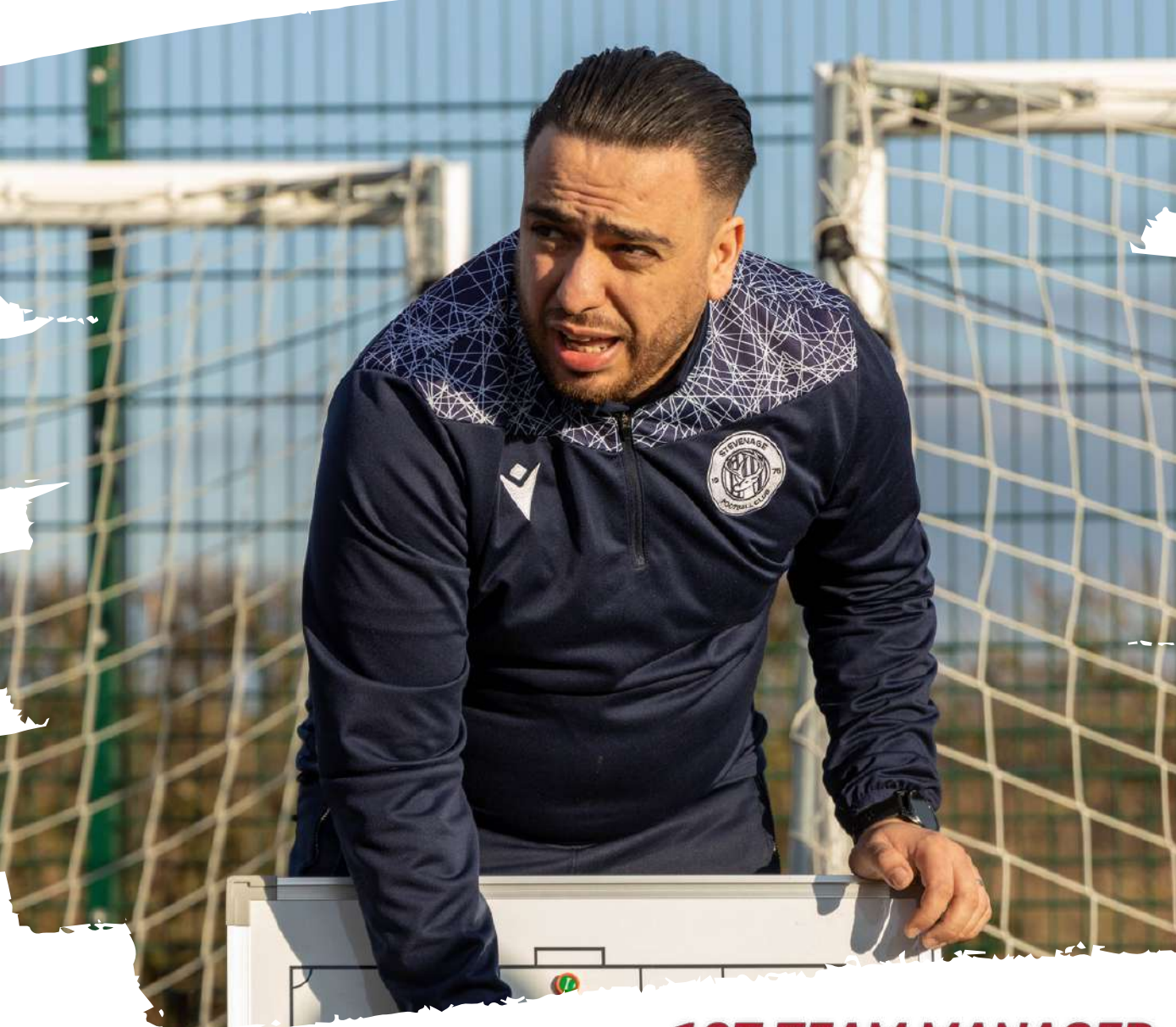

Established in 2009, having previously been known as St Albans City Ladies, tonight's opponents are no stranger to the Boro. The last time the two sides met was back in March in the Hertfordshire FA Womens' County Cup Final in Letchworth, which ended in a 3-1 win for Boro.

The Magpies enjoyed a strong 2021/22 season as they finished in fifth position, winning 10 of their 20 games, drawing 4 and only losing 6. Colney Heath accumulated 34 points and only 4 points behind the runners up.

Colney kicked off their season on the opening day of the season with and 8-1 defeat at the hands of Bowers & Pitsea.

Having recruited extensively in the summer, a familiar face in former 'Boro forward, Paige Pryor, could return to face her old side at The Lamex. An energetic forward with an eye for goal, the 'Boro defence will need to be on top form to keep Pryor quiet on the night.

Stevenage FCW found themselves on the opposite end of their previous result as they fell to a 3-2 defeat at Royston Town. Goals from Amy Gooderham and Becky Shephard were not enough for the 'Boro and the watching crowd of 106 were treated to a hotly contested match.

Stevenage started well and Gooderham saw an early effort saved by Amy Martin. It would take another 15 minutes for her to get another decent opportunity and this one was not squandered. A freekick was awarded to 'Boro which was swung in towards the far post to Vicky Neal who headed the ball downwards. Gooderham was there to meet the ball as it rose again and headed in from close range.

Both teams exchanged chances before Town equalised with seven minutes of the half remaining. Dionne Manning was adjudged to have committed a foul near the right hand corner of the area, Annie Georgiou sent a left footed inswinger that Celine Ray got a hand to, only to see the ball drop over the line.

On the stroke of half-time, 'Boro gave away a free kick for offside which was pumped directly into the Town front line and from the edge of the box a powerful shot was unleashed that Ray could not keep out.

It was with seven minutes of the second half remaining that Shephard levelled the game. After a neat interchange with Shianne Swarres, she let loose a right footed shot from near the away dugout that sailed over Martin.

The joy was shortlived, as four minutes later, Ray punched clear a freekick that sat up nicely for the Town player to hit a clean volley into the net.

GIRLS' PATHWAY UPDATE

Ahead of the 2022/23 season, Stevenage FC Foundation have held three sets of Girls pathway trials for local female footballers who want to further their development in addition to playing for their grassroots team.

The Women and Girls pathway now consists of three development tiers, the Girls Football Centre, Girls Development Centre and our brand new England Football Emerging Talent Centre.

The pathway covers girls aged u9-u16 and links directly with the senior set up. Stevenage FC Women have two GDC graduates signed to the development squad and a further two training with the side.

Our pathway trials saw us engage with over 200 players which is our busiest trial period yet; again showing the growth of female football in the county and nationally.

We are looking forward to the season getting started for all of our players and would like to say a big welcome to all the players who have joined us for the season and welcome back to those who were successful in re-trialling. Congratulations to all!
